SENATE BILL 600

Short Title: Inter-Faith Food Shuttle Funds. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE INTER-FAITH FOOD SHUTTLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Inter-Faith Food Shuttle, a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to help support the organization's Comprehensive Food Stabilization Program, which uses a unique method to freeze perishable food that has a very limited shelf life for distribution at a later date, improving the nutritional impact of meals served in soup kitchens and shelters in seven counties and the transportation of this blast frozen product to other food banks for distribution across an extended area of North Carolina.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
