4	(b) Local. – The governing body of a city that is subject to a lien by the federal
5	government and is not eligible to receive a grant from the federal government until the
6	lien is removed may accept a loan from the county in which the city is located in order
7	to pay its debt to the federal government and have the lien removed. The term of the
8	loan may not exceed three years. This subsection applies only to a city located in a
9	county whose population does not exceed 20,000 according to the most recent annual
10	population estimates certified by the State Budget Officer."
