March 14, 2007 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE NORTH CAROLINA TEACHERS' AND STATE 3 EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN. 4 **INSURANCE** COMPANIES AND HEALTH **MAINTENANCE** 5 ORGANIZATIONS DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, TO PROVIDE 6 COVERAGE FOR INFERTILITY TREATMENT. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.(a)** Effective January 1, 2008, G.S. 135-40.6(8) is amended by 9 adding the following new sub-subdivision to read: Infertility: Infertility studies, in vitro fertilizations, ovum 10 "v. implant placements or transfers, gamete and zygote 11 intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, 12 13 variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm aspirations 14 performed in medically supervised facilities recommended by an attending physician and approved by the 15 16 Executive Administrator and Board of Trustees. In vitro 17 fertilizations, ovum implant placements or transfers, gamete and 18 zygote intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm 19 20 aspirations are covered on the same basis as for maternity 21 benefits." 22 SECTION 1.(b) Effective January 1, 2008, G.S. 135-40.6A(a) is amended by adding the following new subdivision to read: 23 24

"(10) In vitro fertilizations, ovum implant placements or transfers, gamete and zygote intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm aspirations in accordance with G.S. 135-40.6(8)v."

SECTION 1.(c) Coverage of in vitro fertilizations as described in G.S. 135-40.6A(a)(10), as enacted by this act, shall be provided by optional programs offered by the Plan under G.S. 135-39.5B.

SECTION 2. Article 51 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read:

"§ 58-51-63. Coverage for infertility treatment.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, every policy or contract of accident and health insurance, and every preferred provider benefit plan under G.S. 58-50-60 that is issued, renewed, or amended on or after January 1, 2008, that provides maternity benefits shall provide coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility. The same deductibles, coinsurance, and other limitations as apply to similar services covered under the policy, contract, or plan shall apply to coverage for infertility treatment.
- (b) As used in this section, 'infertility treatment' means infertility studies, in vitro fertilizations, ovum implant placements or transfers, gamete and zygote intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm aspirations performed in medically supervised facilities when recommended by an attending physician."

SECTION 3. Article 65 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read:

"§ 58-65-97. Coverage for infertility treatment.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, every insurance certificate or subscriber contract under any hospital service plan or medical service plan governed by this Article and Article 66 of this Chapter, and every preferred provider benefit plan under G.S. 58-50-56 that is issued, renewed, or amended on or after January 1, 2008, that provides maternity benefits shall provide coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility. The same deductibles, coinsurance, and other limitations as apply to similar services covered under the certificate, contract, or plan shall apply to coverage for infertility treatment.
- (b) As used in this section, 'infertility treatment' means infertility studies, in vitro fertilizations, ovum implant placements or transfers, gamete and zygote intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm aspirations performed in medically supervised facilities when recommended by an attending physician."

SECTION 4. Article 67 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read:

"§ 58-67-81. Coverage for infertility treatment.

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, every health care plan written by a health maintenance organization and in force, issued, renewed, or amended on or after January 1, 2008, that is subject to this Article and that provides maternity benefits shall provide coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility. The same deductibles, coinsurance, and other limitations as apply to similar services covered under the plan shall apply to coverage for infertility treatment.

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As used in this section, 'infertility treatment' means infertility studies, in vitro fertilizations, ovum implant placements or transfers, gamete and zygote intrafallopian transfers, intracytoplasmic sperm injections, variocele ligations, and vasovasostomies and sperm aspirations performed in medically supervised facilities when recommended by an attending physician."

SECTION 5. Effective January 1, 2008, G.S. 58-50-155 reads as rewritten: "§ 58-50-155. Standard and basic health care plan coverages.

- Notwithstanding G.S. 58-50-125(c), and any other provision of law to the contrary, the standard health plan developed and approved under G.S. 58-50-125 shall provide coverage for all of the following:
 - Mammograms and examinations and laboratory tests for the screening (1) for the early detection of cervical cancer at least equal to the coverage required by G.S. 58-51-57.
 - (2) Prostate-specific antigen (PSA) tests or equivalent tests for the presence of prostate cancer at least equal to the coverage required by G.S. 58-51-58.
 - (3) Reconstructive breast surgery resulting from a mastectomy at least equal to the coverage required by G.S. 58-51-62.
 - (4) a qualified individual, scientifically proven bone mass measurement for the diagnosis and evaluation of osteoporosis or low bone mass at least equal to the coverage required by G.S. 58-3-174.
 - (5) Prescribed contraceptive drugs or devices that prevent pregnancy and that are approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for use as contraceptives, or outpatient contraceptive services at least equal to the coverage required by G.S. 58-3-178, if the plan covers prescription drugs or devices, or outpatient services, as applicable. The same exceptions and exclusions as are provided under G.S. 58-3-178 apply to standard plans developed and approved under G.S. 58-50-125.
 - Colorectal cancer examinations and laboratory tests at least equal to (6) the coverage required by G.S. 58-3-179.
 - Surveillance tests at least equal to coverage required by G.S. 58-3-266. (7)
 - Infertility treatment at least equal to the coverage required by (8) G.S. 58-51-63.
 - (a1), (a2) Repealed by Session Laws 1999-197, s. 2.
- Notwithstanding G.S. 58-50-125(c), in developing and approving the plans under G.S. 58-50-125, the Committee and Commissioner shall give due consideration to cost-effective and life-saving health care services and to cost-effective health care providers."
- **SECTION 6.** Nothing in this act shall apply to specific accident, specified disease, hospital indemnity, or long-term care health insurance policies.
 - **SECTION 7.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
