A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO STUDY DECONSTRUCTION OF INACTIVE DAMS LOCATED IN NORTH CAROLINA.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1.(a) The Department of Environment and Natural Resources

**SECTION 1.(a)** The Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall conduct a study to examine the feasibility of deconstructing inactive dams located in North Carolina and shall prepare and submit a report based on the results of the study to the Environmental Review Commission no later than January 15, 2009. This study and the report shall include a discussion of:

- (1) Mapping of inactive dams in the State.
- 11 (2) History of each dam and the reason for its inactive status.
- 12 (3) Length of time each dam has been inactive.

- (4) The cost estimates for deconstruction of each inactive dam.
- 14 (5) The barriers to deconstruction of each inactive dam.
- 15 (6) The assessment of deconstruction benefits of each inactive dam.

**SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to conduct the study required by subsection (a) of this section.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
