3 Every other member of the General Assembly shall receive increases in (b) 4 annual salary only to the extent of and in the amounts equal to the average increases 5 received by employees of the State, effective upon convening of the next Regular 6 Session of the General Assembly after enactment of these increased amounts, except no 7 such increase is granted upon the convening of the 1997 Regular Session of the General 8 Assembly. Accordingly, upon convening of the 1997 Regular Session of the General 9 Assembly, every other member of the General Assembly shall be paid an annual salary 10 of thirteen thousand nine hundred fifty one dollars (\$13,951) payable monthly, and an 11 expense allowance of five hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$559.00) per month.

12 (c) The salary and expense allowances provided in this section are in addition to 13 any per diem compensation and any subsistence and travel allowance authorized by any 14 other law with respect to any regular or extra session of the General Assembly, and 15 service on any State board, agency, commission, standing committee and study 16 commission."

SECTION 2. G.S. 120-3.1(a) reads as rewritten:

18 "(a) In addition to compensation for their services, members of the General19 Assembly shall be paid the following allowances:

- A weekly travel allowance for each week or fraction thereof that the
 General Assembly is in regular or extra session. The amount of the
 weekly travel allowance shall be calculated for each member by
 multiplying the actual round-trip mileage from that member's home to
 the City of Raleigh by the rate per mile which is the business standard
 mileage rate set by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51,
 December 27, 1993. Rev. Proc. 2006-49, November 20, 2006.
- A travel allowance at the rate which is the business standard mileage rate set by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51, December 27, 1993, Rev. Proc. 2006-49, November 20, 2006, whenever the member travels, whether in or out of session, as a representative of the General Assembly or of its committees or commissions, with the approval of the Legislative Services 33
- 34 A subsistence allowance for meals and lodging at a daily rate equal to (3) 35 the maximum per diem rate for federal employees traveling to Raleigh, 36 North Carolina, as set out at 58 Federal Register 67959 (December 22, 37 1993), of one hundred thirty-four dollars (\$134.00) while the General 38 Assembly is in session and, except as otherwise provided in this 39 subdivision, while the General Assembly is not in session when, with the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in the case 40 41 of Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in case 42 of Senators, the member is:
- 43a.Traveling as a representative of the General Assembly or of its44committees or commissions, or

2		A member who is authorized to travel, whether in or out of
3		session, within the United States outside North Carolina, may elect to
4		receive, in lieu of the amount provided in the preceding paragraph, a
5		subsistence allowance of twenty-six dollars (\$26.00) a day for meals,
6		plus actual expenses for lodging when evidenced by a receipt
7		satisfactory to the Legislative Services Officer, the latter not to exceed
8		the maximum per diem rate for federal employees traveling to the
9		same place, as set out at 58 Federal Register 67950-67964 (December
10		22, 1993) General Services Administration Per Diem Bulletin 07-1,
11		August 3, 2006 (71 Federal Register 43772-43772, August 2, 2006)
12		and at 59 Federal Register 23702-23709 (May 6, 1994). General
