2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
3 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE IMPACT OF STUDENT MOBILITY ON ACADEMIC
4 PERFORMANCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study the
7 impact of student mobility on academic performance. In the course of the study, the
8 Committee shall consider:

- 9 (1) The mobility rates of different student populations, especially those at risk of
10 academic failure, and the relationship between high mobility rates and
11 student performance for different student populations;
12 (2) Impediments to receiving a sound basic education that are a product of high
13 mobility rates; and
14 (3) Strategies for meeting the needs of students who move frequently, especially
15 students at risk of academic failure.

16 The Committee shall report the results of its study to the 2010 Regular Session of
17 the 2009 General Assembly.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
