That the telephone subscriber has not picked up a filled prescription 15 <u>c.</u> drug for which a valid prescription is on file with a pharmacy 16 licensed pursuant to G.S. 90-85.21. 17 18 d. That an account maintained by the telephone subscriber may be subject to potential fraudulent activity." 19 20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
