Short Title: Clarify Lic Req/Out-of-State Weighmasters.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS FOR OUT-OF-STATE
3 WEIGHMASTERS UNDER THE LAWS REGULATING PUBLIC WEIGHMASTERS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 81A-52 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 81A-52. License.

7 All public weighmasters shall be licensed. Any person not less than 18 years of age who
8 wishes to be a public weighmaster shall apply to the Department on a form provided by the
9 Department. A person operating as a public weighmaster outside of this State shall include with
10 the person's application for licensure in this State a copy of the most recent weighing device
11 inspection report performed by the person's local or state weights and measures officials within
12 the 12-month period immediately preceding the date of application. The Board may adopt rules
13 for determining the qualifications of the applicant for a license. Public weighmasters shall be
14 licensed for a period of one year beginning the first day of July and ending on the thirtieth day
15 of June, and a fee of nineteen dollars (\$19.00) shall be paid for each person licensed at the time
16 of the filing of the application."

17 SECTION 2. G.S. 81A-61 reads as rewritten:

18 "§ 81A-61. Approval of devices used.

19 When making a weight determination, a public weighmaster shall use a weighing device
20 that is of a type suitable for the weighing of the product to be weighed and that has been tested
21 and approved for use by the Commissioner or by the public weighmaster's local or state
22 weights and measures officials within a period of 12 months the 12-month period immediately
23 preceding the date of the weighing."

24 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to applicants
25 for licensure on or after that date.
