4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the	
6	following new section to read:	
7	"§ 52-13. Procedures in causes of action for alienation of affection and criminal	
8	conversation.	
9	No act of the defendant shall give rise to a cause of action for alienation of affection or	
10	criminal conversation after the date of separation of the claimant and the claimant's spouse. An	
11	action for alienation of affection or criminal conversation shall not be commenced more than	
12	one year from the last act of the defendant giving rise to the cause of action. The date of	
13	separation shall be interpreted according to Chapter 50 of the General Statutes. A person may	
14	commence a cause of action for alienation of affection or criminal conversation against a	
15	natural person only."	
16	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to actions	
17	commenced on or after that date.
