6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	SECTION 1. The Division of Social Services of the Department of Health and		
8		ices is directed to adopt all optional provisions of The Food, Conservation, and	
9	Energy Act of 2008, P.L. 110-246, sections 4105, 4106, 4108, and 4119.		
10		ECTION 2. The Division of Social Services is directed to expand eligibility for	
11	the Food and Nutrition Service program by adopting categorical eligibility through Temporary		
12	Assistance for Needy Families, and raising the gross income limit to one hundred sixty-five $response 1(165\%)$ of the following respect to level		
13	percent (165%) of the federal poverty level.		
14	<b>SECTION 3.</b> The Division of Social Services is directed to develop a plan to increase outrach to aligible Food and Nutrition Service applicants and maximize available		
15 16	increase outreach to eligible Food and Nutrition Service applicants and maximize available federal funds for outreach.		
10	<b>SECTION 4.</b> The Division of Social Services is directed to take all steps		
17	permissible under federal law to simplify administration of the Food and Nutrition Service		
19	program, which will increase program participation while reducing county administrative costs,		
20	including lengthening the certification period to the maximum period of time permitted by		
21	federal law, reducing verification requirements, and improving the notices and forms given to		
22	applicants and recipients.		
23	<b>SECTION 5.</b> The Department of Health and Human Services is directed to develop		
24	a plan, in consultation with the Employment Security Commission of North Carolina and the		
25	North Carolina Community College System, to maximize the benefits of the federal Food		
26	Stamp Employment and Training Program to assist as many food stamp recipients in this State		
27	by improving the recipients' ability to obtain regular employment and reduce the recipients'		
28	dependence on public assistance. The plan shall include:

## **General Assembly of North Carolina**

5 **SECTION 7.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
