A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REOUIRE THAT LARGER COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES MAKE 3 RECORDINGS OF CLOSED SESSIONS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-318.10(e) reads as rewritten:

6 Every public body shall keep full and accurate minutes of all official meetings, "(e) including any closed sessions held pursuant to G.S. 143-318.11. Such minutes may be in 7 8 written form or, at the option of the public body, may be in the form of sound or video and 9 sound recordings. When a public body meets in closed session, it shall keep a general account of the closed session so that a person not in attendance would have a reasonable understanding 10 of what transpired. Such accounts may be a written narrative, or video or audio recordings. 11 Such minutes and accounts shall be public records within the meaning of the Public Records 12 Law, G.S. 132-1 et seq.; provided, however, that minutes or an account of a closed session 13 conducted in compliance with G.S. 143-318.11 may be withheld from public inspection so long 14 as public inspection would frustrate the purpose of a closed session. When a public body meets 15 in closed session, it shall make a sound or video and sound recording of that session, which 16 may be withheld from public inspection so long as public inspection would frustrate the 17 purpose of a closed session; provided, this sentence applies only to municipalities with a 18 population of 50,000 or more according to the most recent decennial federal census and to 19 counties with a population of 50,000 or more according to the most recent decennial federal 20 census." 21 22

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
