A law enforcement agency may disseminate an assessment of criminal	<u>intelligence</u>
information to the principal of a school when necessary to avoid imminent danger to	o the life of
a student or employee of the school or to the public school property pursuant to 2	28 C.F.R. §
23.20. The notification may be made in person or by telephone. As used in this sub	section, the
term "school" means any public or private school in the State under Chapter 1	15C of the
General Statutes."	

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009.
