5	conspicuously post at each purchase counter the following warning in block letters not less than	
6	one inch in height the phrase: "IT IS UNLAWFUL TO STORE OR LEAVE A FIREARM	
7	THAT CAN BE DISCHARGED IN A MANNER THAT A REASONABLE PERSON	
8	SHOULD KNOW IS ACCESSIBLE TO A MINOR. IF YOU KEEP A LOADED FIREARM	
9	WITHIN ANY PREMISES UNDER YOUR CUSTODY OR CONTROL, AND A MINOR	
10	OBTAINS IT AND USES IT, RESULTING IN INJURY OR DEATH, OR CARRIES IT TO A	
11	PUBLIC PLACE, YOU MAY BE GUILTY OF A CRIMINAL OFFENSE UNLESS YOU	
12	STORED THE FIREARM IN A LOCKED CONTAINER OR LOCKED THE FIREARM	
13	WITH A LOCKING DEVICE TO KEEP IT FROM TEMPORARILY FUNCTIONING."	
14	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to	1
15	offenses committed on or after that date.
