The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 8 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "Article 16. "Insurance Coverage. "§ 8-115. Evidence of insurance coverage admissible. In any civil proceeding, including the questioning of jurors under G.S. 9-15, counsel of record for the plaintiffs may present evidence or inquire regarding the existence, contents, and coverage of any liability insurance policies held by any defendant." SECTION 2. Rule 411 of the North Carolina Rules of Evidence, as contained in G.S. 8C-1, is repealed. **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to any cause
