SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 7B-1903(d) reads as rewritten:
"(d) Th	ne court may order secure custody for a juvenile who is alleged to have violated
the condition	s of the juvenile's probation or post-release supervision, but only if supervision if
the court finds any of the following:	
<u>(1</u>	the The juvenile is alleged to have committed acts that damage property or
	injure persons.
<u>(2</u>	The juvenile is alleged to have committed acts that pose a danger to the
	juvenile or others.
<u>(3</u>	The juvenile has absconded from the juvenile's current placement and is
	unavailable to be supervised safely."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
