SESSION LAW 2009-219 HOUSE BILL 1419

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION TO DEVELOP A BAT EVICTION AND EXCLUSION CURRICULUM TO BE USED BY OTHER ASSOCIATIONS OR ORGANIZATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 113-333 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d) The Commission is authorized to develop a bat eviction and exclusion curriculum that may be taught by trade associations or wildlife conservation organizations for certification. The curriculum may incorporate the training that is provided as part of Wildlife Damage Control Agent certification in best management practices for removing and evicting bats from structures and in preventing bats from reentering structures."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 25th day of June, 2009.
