| 5 | SECTION 1. G.S. 62A-46 reads as rewritten: |
| 6 | "§ 62A-46. Fund distribution to PSAPs. |

| 8 | (c) Use of Funds. – A PSAP that receives a distribution from the 911 Fund may not use |
| 9 | the amount received to pay for the lease or purchase of real estate, cosmetic remodeling of |
| 10 | emergency dispatch centers, hiring or compensating telecommunicators, or the purchase of |
| 11 | mobile communications vehicles, ambulances, fire engines, or other emergency vehicles. |
| 12 | Distributions received by a PSAP may be used only to pay for the following: |
| 13 | (1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone equipment, |
| 14 | including necessary computer hardware, software, and database |
| 15 | provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of establishing a 911 |
| 16 | system.system, and the lease, purchase, operation, and maintenance of |
| 17 | consoles and communications equipment owned or operated by the PSAP |
| 18 | and physically located within and for the use of the PSAP, and radio or |
| 19 | microwave towers and equipment with lines which terminate in the PSAP. |
