A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A 3 SPECIAL PLATE FOR THE GREEN INDUSTRY COUNCIL.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to 6 "(b) 7 the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be 8 abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued 9 for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, 10 must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in 11 G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word 12 13 "weighted".

14 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less 15 16 shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight" 17 printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying 18 slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a 19 20 "First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification. 21

1	"(b73) Green Industry Council The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
2	the Green Industry Council plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer
3	quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the
4	sale of Green Industry Council plates to the Green Industry Council to be used to provide an
5	umbrella of advocacy for green industry issues, the promotion of the green industry, and
6	educational activities."
7	SECTION 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
