1	"(b73) NC Veterinary Medical Association The Division must receive 300 or more
2	applications for the NC Veterinary Medical Association plate before the plate may be
3	developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural
4	Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of NC Veterinary Medical Association plates to
5	the NC Veterinary Medical Association to be used to provide compassionate, quality health
6	care for all animals, to protect the health of the public, to strengthen the human-animal bond, to
7	provide advanced continuing education for the public."
8	<b>SECTION 6.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
