Short Title: GA Members/Full-Time Legislative Assistants. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Jones; E. Floyd, Hall, Hughes, and Pierce. Referred to: State Government/State Personnel, if favorable, Appropriations. May 6, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT EACH MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ENTITLED TO A FULL-TIME LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANT AND TO REQUIRE THAT THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION ESTABLISH AN EXPERIENCED BASED MINIMUM SALARY FOR LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 7 of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 120-32.7. Members entitled to full-time legislative assistant. Each member of the General Assembly is entitled to have one full-time legislative assistant during the entire term of office." **SECTION 2.** In implementing this act, the Legislative Services Commission shall: Review the range of salaries paid to legislative assistants, including a (1) comparison between the two chambers and relative to compensation in other states.

- (2) Set a minimum base salary for full-time legislative assistants that is based upon work experience and not upon the status of the member of the General Assembly for whom the legislative assistant works.
- (3) Make any appropriate salary adjustments.
