5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-316 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
7	"(e) Teacher assistants who are required by law to have a substitute when they are out of
8	the classroom shall earn and use personal leave under the same terms and conditions as
9	classroom teachers for as long as they are in a position that requires them to have a substitute."
10	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
