13	shall be held harmless until his or her salary is commensurate with years of experience.

15	collect current work experience credit. All work experience as a teacher assistant in any public			
16	school within the State or in another state shall be used in determining total work experience			
17	credit. The State Board of Education shall determine the amount and to what degree other			
18	comparable work experience counts towards teacher assistant work experience credit.			
19	SECTION 1.(d)	The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to
