12 13 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of three million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$3,250,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of three million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$3,250,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year in recurring funds. These funds shall be used to provide funding for the 11 additional Learn and Earn high schools that will be operational in 2009-2010.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
