Short Title: DCR Study Endor Iron Furnace/Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Love; and Hughes. Referred to: Appropriations. May 24, 2010 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF DESIGNATING THE ENDOR IRON FURNACE AS A STATE HISTORIC SITE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE STUDY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The Department of Cultural Resources shall study the feasibility of designating the Endor Iron Furnace as a State Historic Site or a Grassroots Science Museum. The Department shall submit the results of its study to the 2011 General Assembly upon its convening. **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to be used to complete the study authorized in Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
