## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS TO PROTECT CHILDREN FROM ONLINE PREDATORS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's Crime 6 Control Commission the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) to fund 7 grants to schools and school districts for age-appropriate education of students through the 8 online predator curriculum developed by the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) 9 program, or a similar curriculum approved by the Commission that incorporates all of the 10 following elements:

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- (1) Responsible online communication and safe interaction with others online.
- (2) Relating online behavior to real world consequences.
  - (3) Understanding of the threats posed by child predators and appropriate ways to recognize and respond to strangers online.
- (4) Awareness and prevention of risks such as malicious software, spam, and identity theft.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.



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
