A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR STEALING A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR  
2 THE PURPOSE OF STEALING THE MOTOR PARTS AND TO APPROPRIATE  
3 FUNDS TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT TO ASSIST WITH IMPLEMENTATION  
4 COSTS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-72(b) reads as rewritten:

8 "(b) The crime of larceny is a felony, without regard to the value of the property in  
9 question, if the larceny is any of the following:

10 ...

11 (6) Of a motor vehicle with the intent to engage in a violation of G.S. 14-72.7 or  
12 G.S. 14-72.8."

13 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial  
14 Department the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to  
15 assist with the cost of implementing this act.

16 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2010, and applies to  
17 offenses committed on or after that date.
