AN ACT CLARIFYING THE DEFINITION OF BROADBAND INTERNET ACCESS IN NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 62-3(1) reads as rewritten:

- "(1) 'Broadband service' means any service that consists of or includes a high-speed access capability to transmit at a rate of not less than 200 kilobits per second in either the upstream or downstream direction and either (i) is used to provide access to the Internet, or (ii) provides computer processing, information storage, information content, or protocol conversion, including any service applications or information service provided over such high-speed access service. "Broadband service" does not include intrastate a connection to the Internet that provides capacity for transmission at an average speed of at least 1.5 megabits per second downstream and at least 384 kilobits per second upstream, regardless of the technology or medium used to provide the connection. The term includes a connection to the Internet provided by wireless technology, copper wire, fiber-optic cable, coaxial cable, broadband over power lines, or other facilities or future technologies. The term does not include any of the following:
 - a. Value added services in which computer processing applications are used to act on the form, content, code, or protocol of any information transmitted.
 - <u>Value added services providing text, graphic, video, or audio program content for a purpose other than transmission.</u>
 - c. The transmission of video programming or other programming provided by (or generally considered comparable to programming provided by) a television broadcast station or a radio broadcast station, including cable TV, direct broadcast satellite, and digital television.
 - <u>d.</u> <u>Interstate</u> service that was tariffed by the Commission and in effect as of the effective date of this subdivision."

SECTION 2. G.S. 143B-437.45(4) reads as rewritten:

"(4) High-speed broadband Internet access. – Internet access with transmission speeds that are consistent with requirements for high speed broadband Internet access as defined by the Federal Communications Commission from
