A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SANDHILLS FAMILY HERITAGE ASSOCIATION, MANCHESTER CDC, INC., HOLLYWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CLUB, INCORPORATED, SEVENTY FIRST TOWNSHIP CIVIC IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED, AND THE TIFFANY PINES COMMUNITY OUTREACH CENTER TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sandhills Family Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to assist minority landowners living in Harnett, Cumberland, Richmond, and Moore Counties in preserving their lands and protecting their cultural heritage.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester Township of Cumberland County.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year for community association improvements.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Seventy First Township Civic Improvement Association Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to provide civic, cultural, and senior citizen activities.

SECTION 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man."

SECTION 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
