- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2008-158 reads as rewritten:

- 6 "SECTION 4. This act becomes effective August 1, 2008. 2008, and expires June 30,
- 7 2009. The expiration of this act does not relieve a person's liability to file the report required

8 under G.S. 14-344.1(e) for gross receipts received in June 2009. Liability for acts or omissions

9 before the expiration date of this act are not abated or affected by the expiration. Section 3 of

- 10 this act applies to offenses committed on or after that date."
- 11 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
