7	"Section 2	2.3. Mayor; Term of Office; Duties. The Mayor shall be elected by	all the
8	qualified vote	ers of the City for a term of two-four years or until a successor is elected	ed and
9	qualified. The Mayor shall be the official head of the City government and preside at meetings		
10	of the Council; shall have the right to cast one vote, and one vote only, upon any question or		
11	matter before the Council; and shall exercise the powers and duties conferred by law or as		
12	directed by the	e Council."	
13	SE	<b>ECTION 2.</b> This act is effective beginning with the Mayor elected in 2009.	



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
