| SECTION 1. G.S. 20-62.1(a) reads as rewritten: | |

If seller has no identification as 4 described in this sub-subdivision, the secondary metals recycler or 5 salvage yard shall not complete the transaction. Effective July 1, 2010, an individual or entity engaged in the 6 <u>j.</u> 7 business of operating a salvage yard or secondary metals recycler 8 shall file a report with the Division. The report shall be filed at a 9 frequency not less than weekly as determined by the Division. The report shall contain an inventory of all motor vehicles purchased. The 10 11 inventory shall contain the following: the vehicle identification 12 number of each motor vehicle obtained, the date on which the motor 13 vehicle was obtained, the name of the person or entity from whom 14 the motor vehicle was obtained, and a statement of whether the motor vehicle was or will be crushed or disposed of for sale or other 15 purposes. The Division shall allow law enforcement agencies access 16 17 to this data electronically or mechanically. 18 <u>k.</u> A receipt for the purchase of the motor vehicle that is signed by all 19 parties to the sale. 20 (2) Maintain the information required under subdivision (1) of this subsection 21 for not less than two years from the date of the purchase of the motor 22 vehicle." 23

SECTION 23. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to motor vehicles sold to, or purchased by, a secondary metals recycler or salvage yard on or after that date.
