5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall not require the public schools to
7	administer any standardized tests except for those required by federal law or as a condition of
8	federal grants.
9	The State Board of Education shall not expend funds to develop or support any
10	standardized tests except for those required by federal law or as a condition of federal grants.
11	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and expires June 30, 2011.
