**SESSION LAW 2009-46
HOUSE BILL 65**

AN ACT TO REENACT AND CLARIFY THE STATUTE AUTHORIZING
INTELLECTUALLY GIFTED STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN TO
ATTEND COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2001-312, as rewritten by Section 2 of S.L. 2005-77, reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 4.** Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law, and shall apply beginning with the 2001-2002 academic year. Section 2 of this act expires ~~September 1, 2008~~ September 1, 2008, and is reenacted effective March 1, 2009. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
