2	AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION TO ADOPT A
3	POLICY PROHIBITING A FOSTER PARENT FROM SMOKING IN THE PRESENCE
4	OF AN INFANT IN THE FOSTER PARENT'S CARE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 131D-10.5 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"§ 131D-10.5. Powers and duties of the Commission.
8	In addition to other powers and duties prescribed by law, the Commission shall exercise the
9	following powers and duties:

11	(8) Adopt rules establishing a policy to prohibit a foster parent from smoking in
12	the presence of an infant in the foster parent's care pursuant to
13	<u>G.S. 131D-10.10.</u> "
14	SECTION 2. Article 1A of Chapter 131D of the General Statutes is amended by
15	adding a new section to read:
16	"§ 131D-10.10. Policy prohibiting smoking in the presence of an infant in foster care
17	setting.
18	(a) For purposes of this section, the following definitions shall apply:
19	(1) Infant. – A young child less than one year of age.
20	$(2) \qquad \underline{\text{Smoking.} - \text{As defined in G.S. 143-596(5).}}$
21	(b) The Commission shall adopt and enforce a written policy prohibiting a foster parent
22	from smoking in a private residence used to provide licensed foster care on the premises. The
23	policy shall further prohibit a foster parent from smoking in the presence of an infant in the
24	foster parent's care while the infant and the foster parent are in a motor vehicle. The policy shall
25	require a foster parent to prohibit others from smoking in the presence of an infant in that foster
26	parent's care."
27	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
