A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW CAMDEN COUNTY TO REGULATE GOLF CARTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-300.5 reads as rewritten:

"§ 160A-300.5. Regulation of golf carts on streets in certain localities.

- (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, a town-municipality may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of golf carts on any public street or highway within the eity limits, limits of the municipality, or on any property owned or leased by the eity-municipality. For the purposes of this section, a municipality is defined as a city, county, town, or village.
- (b) By ordinance, a <u>eity-municipality</u> may require the registration of golf carts, charge a fee for the registration, specify who is authorized to operate golf carts, and specify the required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf carts.
- (c) This section applies to the City of Saluda and the Towns of Badin, Carolina Beach, Emerald Isle, Faison, Fremont, Indian Beach, Kings Mountain, Kure Beach, Morrisville, Shelby, and Wrightsville Beach only. Wrightsville Beach, and to the County of Camden."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
