AN ACT TO INCREASE THE LIMIT ON RAFFLE PRIZES.

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-309.15(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) The maximum cash prize that may be offered or paid for any one raffle is fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) and if merchandise is used as a prize, and it is not redeemable for cash, the maximum fair market value of that prize may be fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000). No real property may be offered as a prize in a raffle. The total cash prizes offered or paid by any nonprofit organization or association may not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) in any calendar year. The total fair market value of all prizes offered by any nonprofit organization or association, either in cash or in merchandise that is not redeemable for cash, may not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) in any calendar year."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
