A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO PROHIBIT COVERAGE FOR ABORTIONS UNDER THE STATE HEALTH PLAN FOR TEACHERS AND STATE EMPLOYEES.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1.(a) G.S. 135-45.8 is amended by adding the following new subdivision to read:  "§ 135-45.8. General limitations and exclusions.  The following shall in no event be considered covered expenses nor will benefits described in G.S. 135-45.6 through G.S. 135-45.11 be payable for:		
"( <u>25</u>	Charges for medical or surgical abortion procedures. As used subdivision, "abortion" means the use or prescription of any insemination of a woman known to be pregnant, for reasons other that the life or preserve the health of an unborn child, to remove a dear child, or to deliver an unborn child prematurely, by accepted procedures in order to preserve the health of both the mother and the child.
