<u>(10)</u> To a disabled veteran if the motor vehicle has been specifically modified to enable the disabled veteran to operate the vehicle or be transported in the vehicle. Qualifying modifications include wheelchair lift, lowered floor, running boards, grab bar, steering wheel knob, wheelchair hoist, hand-controlled accelerator and brake, or similar modifications necessary to accommodate the disabled veteran's disability for purposes of operating the vehicle or being transported in the vehicle."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to transfers made on or after that date.
