February 12, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTIES IMPOSED BY THE PRESIDING JUDGE, THAT A PERSON CONVICTED OF DRIVING WHILE IMPAIRED BE IMPRISONED FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FOUR HOURS IN A CONFINEMENT FACILITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-179 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: A defendant convicted of impaired driving and the evidence having shown that the defendant had an alcohol concentration of .20 or higher shall be imprisoned for a mandatory period of 24 hours. This period of imprisonment is to run consecutively, not concurrently, with any other penalty imposed under the provisions of this section." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
