The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 9 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 105-241.24. Additional payments on delayed refunds. In addition to the interest set forth in G.S. 105-142.21 of this Article, the Secretary shall pay an amount equally to ten percent (10%) of the refund, subject to a minimum of five dollars (\$5.00), if the refund is not paid from a date 45 days after the latest of the following dates: The date the final return was filed. (1) The date the final return was due to be filed. (2) The date of the overpayment of a tax levied under Article 4 or Article 8B of (3) this Chapter, as determined in accordance with section 6611(d), (f), (g), and (h) of the Code." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1,
