	Punishments. – Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law
	reater punishment, the following classifications apply to the offenses set forth in
this section:	
(1) Aggravated felony death by vehicle is a Class D felony.
(2) Felony death by vehicle is a Class <u>E-D felony</u> .
(3) Aggravated felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class E felony.
(4) Felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class <u>F-E</u> felony.
(5) Misdemeanor death by vehicle is a Class 1 misdemeanor."
