February 19, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE REPORT OF A CRASH INVOLVING A MOTOR VEHICLE 3 AND A BICYCLE WHERE THE TOTAL PROPERTY DAMAGE EXCEEDS FIVE 4 HUNDRED DOLLARS. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-4.01(33b) reads as rewritten: 7 "(33b) Reportable Crash. – A crash involving a motor vehicle that results in one or 8 more of the following: 9 Death or injury of a human being. a. Total property damage of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more, or 10 b. property damage of any amount to a vehicle seized pursuant to G. S. 11 12 20-28.3. 13 Total property damage of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or more and <u>c.</u> involves a bicycle as defined in G.S. 20-171.8(1)." 14

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
