A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE OFFICE OF MEN'S HEALTH WITHIN THE 3 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, AS RECOMMENDED BY 4 THE PUBLIC HEALTH STUDY COMMISSION. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Chapter 130A of the General Statutes is amended by adding the 6 7 following new Article to read: 8 "Article 5A. 9 "Men's Health. 10 "§ 130A-131.26. Office of Men's Health established. There is established in the Department the Office of Men's Health. The purpose of 11 (a) the Office is to expand the State's public health concerns and focus to include a comprehensive 12 outlook on the overall health status of men. The primary goals of the Office shall be the 13 14 prevention of disease and improvement in the quality of life for men over their entire lifespan. The Department shall develop strategies for achieving these goals which shall include, but not 15 16 be limited to: 17 Developing a strategic plan to improve public services and programs (1)18 targeting men; 19 Conducting policy analyses on specific issues related to men's health; (2)20 (3) Facilitating communication among the Department's programs and between 21 the Department and external men's health groups and community-based 22 organizations; 23 Building public health awareness and capacity regarding men's health issues (4) 24 by providing a series of services, including evaluation, recommendation, 25 technical assistance, and training; and Developing initiatives for modification or expansion of health services 26 (5) 27 oriented towards men's health issues with the intent of establishing meaningful public/private partnerships in the future. 28 The Office shall study the feasibility of establishing initiatives for: 29 (b) 30 (1)Early intervention services for men infected with HIV; and Outreach, treatment, and follow-up services to men at high risk for 31 (2)contracting sexually transmitted diseases. 32 33 In conducting the study, the Department shall take into consideration related services already in place in the Department and at the local level." 34
