8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-81.12(b2) (1c) reads as rewritten:
10	"(1c) Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. – The revenue derived
11	from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Friends of the
12	Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used for educational
13	materials, preservation programs, capital improvements for the portion of the
14	Great Smoky Mountains National Park that is located in North Carolina, and
15	operating expenses of the Great Smoky Mountains National Parkrelated
16	administrative and operating expenses."
17	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:
18	"(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to
19	the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be
20	abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued
21	for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more,
22	must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in
23	G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The
24	plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word
25	"weighted".
26	Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division
27	for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less

shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight"
printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate
shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying
slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a
"First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be
approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.
