SENATE BILL 400

Short Title: No Increase in UNC In-State Tuition or Fees. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
NORTH CAROLINA SHALL NOT INCREASE IN-STATE TUITION OR CERTAIN
FEES AT ANY CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION UNTIL AUGUST 1, 2010.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1.(a) The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall not increase the rate of in-State tuition or fees under G.S. 116-143 at any constituent institution from the rate established for the 2008-2009 fiscal year until August 1, 2010.

SECTION 1.(b) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply to any fee that is related to existing debt service on a new facility for which the State is obligated to pay debt service.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
