## 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT AMENDING THE LAWS PERTAINING TO ON-SITE WASTEWATER 3 CONTRACTORS AND INSPECTORS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. G.S. 90A-71 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 90A-71. Definitions. 7 The following definitions apply in this Article: "Board" means the North Carolina On-Site Wastewater Contractors and 8 (1)Inspectors Certification Board. 9 10 (2) "Contractor" means a person who constructs, installs, or repairs, or offers to construct, install, or repair an on-site wastewater system in the State. 11 "Conventional wastewater system" has the same meaning as in 12 (3) 13 G.S. 130A-343(a)(3). 14 "Department" means the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. (4) "Inspector" means a person who conducts an inspection of an on-site 15 (5) wastewater system at any time after the local health department has issued 16 an operation permit pursuant to G.S. 130A-337.in accordance with rules 17 18 adopted by the Board. "Inspection" means an examination of an on-site wastewater system 19 (5a) 20 permitted under the provisions of Article 11 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes, when requested by a lending institution, realtor, prospective 21 homebuyer, or other impacted party as a condition of sale, refinancing, or 22 transfer of title, which examination shall meet the minimum requirements 23 24 established by the Board. "On-site wastewater system" means any wastewater system permitted under 25 (6)the provisions of Article 11 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes that 26 does not discharge to a treatment facility or the surface waters of the State. 27 "Person" means all persons, including individuals, firms, partnerships, 28 (7) associations, public or private institutions, municipalities, or political 29 30 subdivisions, governmental agencies, or private or public corporations organized and existing under the laws of this State or any other state or 31 32 country. "Wastewater treatment facility" means a mechanical or chemical treatment 33 (8) facility serving a site with multiple wastewater sources." 34 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 90A-72 reads as rewritten: 35
