4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-16.10 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 14-16.10. Definitions.**

7 The following definitions apply in this Article:

8 (1) Court officer. – Magistrate, clerk of superior court, acting clerk, assistant or
9 deputy clerk, judge, or justice of the General Court of Justice; district
10 attorney, assistant district attorney, or any other attorney designated by the
11 district attorney to act for the State or on behalf of the district attorney;
12 public defender or assistant defender; court reporter; probation or parole
13 officer; juvenile court counselor as defined in G.S. 7B-1501(18a); any
14 attorney or other individual employed by or acting on behalf of the
15 department of social services in proceedings pursuant to Subchapter I of
16 Chapter 7B of the General Statutes; any attorney or other individual
17 appointed pursuant to G.S. 7B-601 or G.S. 7B-1108 or employed by the
18 Guardian ad Litem Services Division of the Administrative Office of the
19 Courts.

20 (2) Executive officer. – A person named in G.S. 147-3(c).

21 (3) Legislative officer. – A person named in G.S. 147-2(1), (2), or (3)."

22 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
23 offenses committed on or after that date.
