5	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-746(a) reads as rewritten:		
6	"§ 143-746. Internal auditing required.		
7	(a) Requirements. – A State agency shall establish a program of internal auditing that:		
8 9	(1) Implements an effective system of internal controls that safeguards public funds and assets and minimizes incidences of fraud, waste, and abuse.		
10	(2) Ensures programs and business operations are administered in compliance		
11	with federal and state laws, regulations, and other requirements.		
12	(3) Reviews the effectiveness and efficiency of agency and program operations		
13	and service delivery. delivery, in consultation with the Office of		
14	Management Innovation.		
15	(4) Periodically audits the agency's major systems and controls, including:		
16	a. Accounting systems and controls.		
17	b. Administrative systems and controls.		
18	c. Electronic data processing systems and controls."
