Internal auditing required. 7 Requirements. – A State agency shall establish a program of internal auditing that: (a) 8 Implements an effective system of internal controls that safeguards public funds and assets and minimizes incidences of fraud, waste, and abuse. 9 Ensures programs and business operations are administered in compliance 10 (2) with federal and state laws, regulations, and other requirements. 11 Reviews the effectiveness and efficiency of agency and program operations 12 (3) 13 and service delivery, in consultation with the Office of Management Innovation. 14 Periodically audits the agency's major systems and controls, including: 15 (4) Accounting systems and controls. 16 17 h. Administrative systems and controls. Electronic data processing systems and controls." 18 c. 19 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 147 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 20 Article to read: 21

"Article 3E.

"Office of Management Innovation.

"§ 147-33.120. Office of Management Innovation established.

The North Carolina Office of Management Innovation (Office) is established within the Office of State Budget and Management to provide training and support for State agencies to implement Lean Management strategies, Total Quality Management strategies, the principles of the Theory of Constraints, and efficiency and economy best practices.

"§ 147-33.121. Duties.

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The Office shall:

- Encourage State agencies to adopt managerial accounting methods to assist (1) managers in decision making.
- Train state agencies to identify ways to improve the effectiveness and (2) efficiency of agency and program operations and service.
- Implement a train the trainer process. (3)
- Assist State agencies in implementing efficiency programs, including, but (4) not limited to, the following:
 - Lean Management.



- 17 (4) Management Information Systems.
- 18 (5) Activity-based costing.
- The Director may hire additional administrative staff to support the core staff."
- SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
