BILL SUMMARY: This bill requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to study the feasibility of tolling all interstate highways entering into the state and specifies elements to be considered in the study. It also requires the DOT to report to the Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee and the Fiscal Research Division by March 1, 2010.

A House committee substitute filed on April 8, 2009, makes technical changes only.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The Department of Transportation is already doing an update to a financial feasibility study and would incorporate this requirement, making the cost negligible.
